- Number of resident positive COVID Cases: 91
  - Apartments/Assisted Living: 11
    - 2 in SVO 2nd floor
    - 3 in SVO 3<sup>rd</sup> floor (1 resolved)
    - 6 in SVO 4<sup>th</sup> floor (2 resolved)
  - Long Term Care (LTC): 80 Positive tests
    - 25 in SVO 1<sup>st</sup> floor (10 resolved)
    - 30 in SVO 2<sup>nd</sup> floor (19 resolved)
    - 19 in SVToo 1<sup>st</sup> floor (2 resolved)
    - 6 in SVtoo 2<sup>nd</sup> floor (1 resolved)

We are sad to say that today we have had 18 residents pass-away. Our heartfelt sympathies go out to their families and loved one's.
