- Number of staff who have tested positive for COVID: 72 (62 resolved)
- Number of resident positive COVID Cases: 90
  - o Apartments/Assisted Living: 15 (6 resolved)
    - 1 in SVO 1<sup>st</sup> floor
    - 5 in SVO 2<sup>nd</sup> floor
    - 3 in SVO 3<sup>rd</sup> floor
    - 6 in SVO 4<sup>th</sup> floor
  - Long Term Care (LTC): 80 Positive tests (63 resolved)
    - 23 in SVO 1<sup>st</sup> floor (18 resolved)
    - 30 in SVO 2<sup>nd</sup> floor (30 resolved)
    - 21 in SVToo 1<sup>st</sup> floor (14 resolved)
    - 6 in SVtoo 2<sup>nd</sup> floor (1 resolved)

\*\* In addition to this, 3 essential caregivers have also tested positive, and 4 individuals are in hospital. Sadly, one of our residents has passed-away in the last 24 hours. Our hearts go out to the family, friends and loved one's.
