








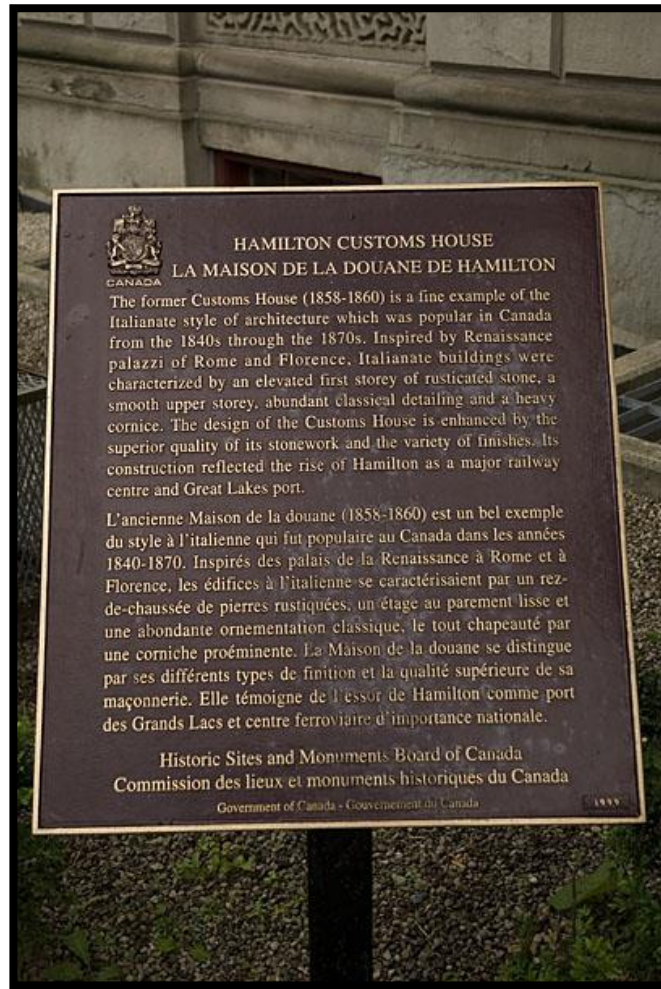

HAMILTON CUSTOMS HOUSE (HCH) built circa 1858

51 STUART STREET OFF BAY STREET N.

CURRENT DESIGNATION: WORKERS ARTS AND HERITAGE CENTRE

The Hamilton Customs House is one of the oldest remaining federal public buildings in Canada and has been designated a National Historic Site. The structure's finely crafted "Italianate architecture" reflected the rise of Hamilton as a major railway and Great Lakes port in the mid 1800's.

Beginning in 1860, seventeen men earned their wages at the site as staff of the Customs Department. They dealt daily with dozens of sailors, longshoremen, railway men, and teamsters delivering and picking up goods subject to duties.

In 1887 the Customs Office moved to another location. The Stuart St. site became host to a variety of successive enterprises including a day school, a YWCA centre, a pasta factory, and a haven for the homeless.

In 1995, the Ontario Workers Art and Heritage Centre bought and renovated the building and created an interpretive centre for workers history and culture in Hamilton and surrounding area.

Exhibits include a wide array of artifacts, art works, photographs etc. related to the life and culture of workers in past years. Examples include pre-1900 factory tools and office equipment, factory uniforms and instruction manuals, pictures of workers on the job and at home.

LEGEND (unconfirmed); THE DARK LADY OF HCH came from England as a young girl. On ship she had an affair with the ship's captain. When the ship arrived in Hamilton, the captain (a married man) feared scandal, strangled the young girl, and buried her body in the basement of HCH.

Employees and visitors to HCH have told stories of seeing a faint image of a girl in the basement of HCH lamenting the loss of her seaman lover.
