



Hamilton History: DOFASCO

ArcelorMittal Dofasco is a steel company based in Hamilton, Ontario. Dofasco is a standalone subsidiary of ArcelorMittal, the world's largest integrated steel producer.

Clifton Sherman and Frank A. Sherman founded the steel giant that would help bring prosperity and identity to the city of Hamilton. Dofasco was incorporated as Dominion Steel Castings Company Limited in 1912, becoming Dominion Foundries and Steel Company in 1917. Its nickname "Dofasco" was adopted as its legal name in 1980.

Frank H. Sherman (Frank A.'s son) introduced to Dofasco and North America in 1954 the method of steel production known as Basic Oxygen Steelmaking. With BOS, the same quantity and quality of steel is manufactured in one-twelfth the time it took previous steelmaking methods. BOS production is superior because the oxygen pumped into the furnace limits impurities, (primarily nitrogen), that previously had entered the furnace from outside air.

Dofasco owned The Adams Iron Ore mines in Timiskaming Northeastern Ontario until 1990 when the world economy entered into recession and The Adams Mine was closed. Dofasco lost \$900 million in three years from 1991 and was forced to implement its first employee layoffs since the Great Depression of the 1930s.

Over the years, Dofasco owned and operated a number of subsidiaries, including National Steel Car, a Hamilton-based railway freight car manufacturer, (1962 to 1994). Dofasco has won awards for being the "most sustainable manufacturing company" in North America.

In January 2006, Luxembourg-based Arcelor, then the world's second largest steel producer by volume, purchased Dofasco in part because of its operating efficiency in producing high quality products, non-unionized workforce and strong automotive customer base. A "friendly" purchase was negotiated under which the employee profit-sharing plan was continued. Dofasco's Board accepted Arcelor's final offer of \$71 per share in cash, worth an estimated \$5.5 billion.

Three months later Arcelor was itself taken over by Mittal the world's largest steel producer, Dofasco is now part of the combined ArcelorMittal, and has been integrated into their international operations. Unlike rival Stelco, Dofasco is not unionized. Several attempts have been made to organize a union at DFS by the United Steelworkers of America. These efforts were never successful in part because Dofasco employees generally received benefits comparable to the benefits Stelco employees obtained after Stelco went on strike.

In 2020, Dofasco was named one of Canada's Top 100 Employers by Maclean's Magazine. Since 1970, the company has used the same basic award-winning slogan, "Our product is steel. Our strength is people." Since 1937, Dofasco has annually held a huge company Christmas party, typically featuring 30,000 guests and a 30-foot (9 m) tree. Originally, the party was held in one of the large mill buildings on Gage Ave N. From 1993 to 2009, the party was held at Copps Coliseum and was later moved to the company-owned recreation park. Net profit of ArcelorMittal to June 30, 2023, was \$14.95 billion.
